

## Electronic Communications and Signature Consent

This Electronic Communications and Signature Consent Policy (the "E-Sign Policy") describes how Legion delivers electronic communications in connection with your use of our Services and supplement and modify our Terms. We provide our Services in a variety of ways, including electronically through the Internet, email, text-messaging, and/or software applications. When we're providing you with our Services, we retain the right to provide you with certain Communications (as defined below) in electronic form and to obtain your electronic signature as necessary for those Communications. While you are welcome to not agree with this E-Signature Policy or withdraw your consent in the future, you acknowledge that we retain the right to restrict or terminate your access to your account if you withdraw your consent to receive electronic Communications. Any undefined terms we use in this E-Signature Policy have the meanings given to such terms in our Terms of Service. We recommend that you print a copy of this E-Signature Policy for future reference.

**Consent to Electronic Transactions** By accessing the Site or using the Services, you affirmatively consent to conduct all transactions and receive all communications, notices, disclosures, and agreements ("Communications") from the Company and third-party projects electronically. You agree that any electronic signature, including "click-to-accept" or "click-to-agree" actions on the Site, constitutes your valid and binding legal signature under Law No. 51 of 2008 of the Republic of Panama.

**Legal Effect of Electronic Signatures** You acknowledge and agree that electronic signatures, data messages, and electronic documents have the same legal effect, validity, and enforceability as handwritten signatures and paper-based documents. You waive any rights or requirements under any laws or regulations in any jurisdiction which require an original (non-electronic) signature or delivery or retention of non-electronic records.

**Hardware and Software Requirements** To access and retain electronic Communications, you must have a device with internet access, a standard web browser, and the ability to view and store PDF files or web pages. You are responsible for ensuring your hardware and software are compatible with these requirements. If these requirements change in a way that creates a material risk that you will not be able to access subsequent Communications, the Company will provide you with a notice of the revised requirements.

**Withdrawal of Consent** You may withdraw your consent to receive Communications electronically at any time by contacting our support team. However, because our Services are digital in nature, withdrawing your consent may result in the immediate termination of your account and your ability to access the Site and use the Services. Any withdrawal of your consent will be effective only after we have a reasonable period of time to process your request.

**Requests for Paper Copies** The Company is not obligated to provide paper copies of Communications. However, we may, at our sole discretion, provide a paper copy upon request. We reserve the right to charge a reasonable administrative fee for the preparation and mailing of paper documents.

**Accuracy of Contact Information** You agree to keep your email address and other contact information up to date in your Legion account profile. You agree that any Communication sent to the email address on file shall be deemed received by you at the time it is sent.
